Pressing into Better FAMILY Living

The African American community has seen great erosion in the biblical model of a family. This erosion is now touching families of almost every ethnic group in the USA. The erosion is so great that this generation wants us to change the definition of family, marriage, husband, wife, children, and grandparents in order to fit what we look like today.

The family is the part of our existence that affects this life and the life to come (Ephesians 3:14-19). The family is our building material for good success in the earth today. PERSONAL Growth

2. **Correcting or eliminating** bad habits;

Pressing into Better Financial Success

Pressing into better financially has two **(2) requirements**: giving to God and faithful **management**. The first requirement is giving to God in **tithes** and **offerings**. The tithe is a dime out of every dollar. An offering is whatever we are led to give over and above the tithe. It is the wonderful privilege of every believer in order to build a **kingdom-building investment portfolio** which provides divine protection for all that we have. Make this year your year for **proving God** who will open the windows of heaven, rebuke the devourer, and activate Luke 6:38 as a force working in our lives and in our affairs.

The second requirement for better is good financial **management**. In Proverbs 21:20, the Bible says that “There is **treasure** (*savings*) to be desired and **oil** (*needed things*) in the **dwelling** (*house*) of the **wise**; but a **foolish** man spendeth it up.” To press into better, we must save (build a reserve); we must always keep an eye on what we see around us in order to not waste money on things we don’t need; and we must stop running out and going for broke (when money is low **STOP SPENDING**).

Pressing into Being a Better Member

Consistent visibility is required to Press Into Better.
