Psalms 91:14-16 (KJV) Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. *15* He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I *will be* with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. *16* With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.

Psalms 91:14-16 (TLB) For the Lord says, "Because he loves me, I will rescue him; I will make him great because he trusts in my name. *15* When he calls on me, I will answer; I will be with him in trouble and rescue him and honor him. *16* I will satisfy him with a full life and give him my salvation."

Nahum 1:7-9 (TLB) The Lord is good. When trouble comes, he is the place to go! And he knows everyone who trusts in him! *8* But he sweeps away his enemies with an overwhelming flood; he pursues them all night long. *9* What are you thinking of, Nineveh, to defy the Lord? He will stop you with one blow; he won't need to strike again.

Jeremiah 30:17 (KJV) For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast, *saying*, This *is* Zion, whom no man seeketh after.

Jeremiah 30:17 (TLB) I will give you back your health again and heal your wounds. Now you are called 'The Outcast' and 'Jerusalem, the Place Nobody Wants.'

With Forgiveness Comes Healing

1 Peter 2:24 (KJV) Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

1 Peter 2:24 (TLB) He personally carried the load of our sins in his own body when he died on the cross so that we can be finished with sin and live a good life from now on. For his wounds have healed ours!

Proverbs 4:20-22 (KJV) My son, tend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. *21* Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. *22* For they *are* life unto those that find them, and health all their flesh.

Proverbs 4:20-22 (TLB) Listen, son of mine, to what I say. Listen carefully. *21* Keep these thoughts ever in mind; let them penetrate deep within your heart, *22* for they will mean real life for you and radiant health.

He Sent His Word and Healed Them and Delivered Them

Psalms 107:17-21 (KJV) Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted. *18* Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death. *19* Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, *and* he saveth them out of their distresses. *20* He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered *them* from their destructions. *21* Oh that *men* would praise the LORD

for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!

Psalms 107:17-21 (TLB) Others, the fools, were ill because of their sinful ways. *18* Their appetites were gone, and death was near. *19* Then they cried to the Lord in their troubles, and he helped them and delivered them. *20* He spoke, and they were healed—snatched from the door of death. *21* Oh, that these men would praise the Lord for his loving-kindness and for all of his wonderful deeds!

Psalms 30:1-3 (TLB) I will praise you, Lord, for you have saved me from my enemies. You refuse to let them triumph over me. *2* O Lord my God, I pleaded with you, and you gave me my health again. *3* You brought me back from the brink of the grave, from death itself, and here I am alive!

Psalms 75:1 (KJV) Unto thee, O God, do we give thanks, *unto thee* do we give thanks: for *that* thy name is near thy wondrous works declare.

Psalms 75:1 (TLB) How we thank you, Lord! Your mighty miracles give proof that you care.

Psalms 118:16-18 (KJV) The right hand of the LORD is exalted: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly. *17* I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD. *18* The LORD hath chastened me sore: but he hath not given me over unto death.

Psalms 118:16-18 (TLB) *17* I shall not die but live to tell of all his deeds. *18* The Lord has punished me but not handed me over to death.

Have Faith In God

Hebrews 11:1 (KJV) Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:1 (TLB) What is faith? It is the confident assurance that something we want is going to happen. It is the certainty that what we hope for is waiting for us, even though we cannot see it up ahead.

Believe that You Receive IT

Mark 11:12-14, 20-24 (KJV) And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry: *13* And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came

to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not *yet.* *14* And Jesus answered and said unto it, No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever. And his disciples heard *it.* *20* And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. *21* And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away. *22* And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. *23* For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. *24* Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.



Speaking the Word is Sending It Against Every Circumstance

Mark 11:20-24 (TLB) Next morning, as the disciples passed the fig tree he had cursed, they saw that it was withered from the roots! *21* Then Peter remembered what Jesus had said to the tree on the previous day and exclaimed, "Look, Teacher! The fig tree you cursed has withered!" *22* In reply Jesus said to the disciples, "If you only have faith in God— *23* this is the absolute truth—you can say to this Mount of Olives, 'Rise up and fall into the Mediterranean,' and your command will be obeyed. All that's required is that you really believe and have no doubt! *24* Listen to me! You can pray for anything, and if you believe, you have it; it's yours!

Effective Agreement in Prayer

Matthew 18:18-19 (KJV) Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. *19* Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

Matthew 18:18-19 (TLB) And I tell you this—whatever you bind on earth is bound in heaven, and whatever you free on earth will be freed in heaven. *19* I also tell you this—if two of you agree down here on earth concerning anything you ask for, my Father in heaven will do it for you.

There Is Not Question That He Will Do What He Says

Hebrews 10:23 (KJV) Let us hold fast the profession of *our* faith without wavering; (for he *is* faithful that promised;)

Hebrews 10:23 (TLB) Now we can look forward to the salvation God has promised us. There is no longer any room for doubt, and we can tell others that salvation is ours, for there is no question that he will do what he says.
